



All Round Ability Scholarships – Performing Arts

St John's Anglican College is one of south-west Brisbane's premier Performing Arts schools. If your child has been identified as talented then St John's Anglican College would like to extend an invitation to your child to be considered for an All Rounder Scholarship – Performing Arts.

There are two rounds of Performing Arts Scholarship allocations each year; end of Term One and end of Term Three. To be considered in either round you must have your application **completed in full** and submitted prior to the test dates which will be available on the St John's website.

Scholarships may be offered to students who exhibit qualities compatible with the ethos of the College together with –

- Evidence of solo performing experience eg. Eisteddfod's, Dance Schools, TCL Speech and Drama examinations
- A commitment to participate in the school's PACE (Performing Arts Centre of Excellence) program
- A commitment to all rehearsals and performances associated with the relevant ensemble
- Success in the Edutest, Academic Ability test (conducted by St John's Anglican College) in March and September each year
- Sound levels of academic achievement – Applicants must be able to maintain a B or C grade, or higher in all subjects
- Maintaining a B grade or higher in Engagement with Learning, Preparedness for Learning in classes and Classroom Behaviour
- Evidence of exemplary behaviour and presentation (successful applicants are required to represent St John's in correct College uniform)
- A satisfactory interview with the Head of College, Deputy Head of College – Pastoral Care and the Head of Performing Arts
- Two character references from either, a current teacher, a current tutor or a Minister of Religion
- Minimum levels of attainment in the following areas -

Year 7

Grade 4	Violins, Viola, Cello, Flute, Clarinet, and Trumpet
Grade 3	Trombones, Oboe, Bassoon, French Horn, Tuba
Grade 2	Voice

Year 8

Grade 4	Trombones, Oboe, Bassoon, French Horn, Tuba
Grade 5	Violins, Viola, Cello, Flute, Clarinet, and Trumpet

However in the case of late music lesson starters who show exceptional talent or potential, these standards would be reviewed.

NOTE: Applicants will be auditioned to assess their performance. Applicants should provide their own accompanist. If this is not possible the Performing Arts department can arrange for an accompanist. Applicants will be required to perform two contrasting pieces. Applicants who wish to demonstrate their ability on more than one instrument/voice are encouraged to do so and to indicate this on the attached application form.
