



All Rounder Scholarships – Sport

St John's Anglican College is one of south-west Brisbane's emerging premier sporting schools. If your child has been identified as a talented athlete then St John's Anglican College would like to extend an invitation to your child to be considered for an All Rounder Scholarship - Sport.

There are two rounds of Sporting Scholarship allocations each year; end of Term One and end of Term Three. To be considered in either round you must have your application **completed in full** and submitted prior to the test dates which will be available on the St John's website.

Scholarships may be offered to students who exhibit qualities compatible with the ethos of the College together with –

- Evidence of competition at a Regional or State level in a school sport
- A commitment to compete in a school sport each semester
- Success in the Edutest, Academic Ability test (conducted by St John's Anglican College) in March and September each year
- Sound levels of academic achievement – Applicants must be able to maintain a B or C grade, or higher in all subjects
- Maintaining a B grade or higher in Engagement with Learning, Preparedness for Learning in classes and Classroom Behaviour
- Evidence of exemplary behaviour and presentation (successful applicants are required to represent St John's in correct College uniform)
- A satisfactory interview with the Head of College , Deputy Head of College – Pastoral Care and the Head of HPE and Sport
- Two character references from either, a current teacher, a current sporting coach or a Minister of Religion
