6.15pm	Families commence arriving and check master lists at Administration &/or Library for Home Group class allocations/rooming information.
6.30pm	Assemble in allocated Home Group classroom
6.35pm	Home Group teacher to address families on all matters relating to the start of the year. Explain routines, rules, expectations, etc. Issue timetables, diaries, camp medical/permission forms, etc. During this period of time, members of the leadership team will be roving between classes to assist with further queries if needed.
7.00pm	MYP information session in Auditorium for all Year 7-9 parents and students.
7.30pm	Induction evening concludes.

**WHY DO WE HOLD INDUCTION EVENINGS?**

These evenings provide an excellent opportunity for staff, students and parents to begin the year with correct and accurate information on many facets of the students' education at St John's Anglican College.

The Home Group session provides parents with an opportunity to meet other parents of students in their child's home group class as well as introducing students to each other and their home group teacher. Teachers will issue student diaries and timetables as well as discuss homework and behavioural expectations. The night is designed to give an overview of the academic and pastoral nature of the day-to-day experiences so that students in the Middle School are well prepared and comfortable for the start of school.
