



## **All Rounder Scholarships – Sport**

St John's Anglican College is one of south-west Brisbane's emerging premier sporting schools. If your child has been identified as a talented athlete, then St John's Anglican College would like to extend an invitation to your child to be considered for an All Rounder Scholarship - Sport.

To be considered students are required to commit to play a school sport each trimester as per the sports detailed by **The Associated Sports** (TAS) competition and may be required to attend trial days. Students who have a high level of achievement in a non-school sport may be considered for a Bursary.

Scholarships may be offered to students who exhibit qualities compatible with the ethos of the College together with –

- Evidence of competition at a **Regional or State level in a school sport**
- A commitment to compete in a school sport each term
- Sound levels of academic achievement – Applicants must be able to maintain a B or C grade, or higher in all subjects
- Maintaining a B grade or higher in Engagement with Learning, Preparedness for Learning in classes and Classroom Behaviour
- Evidence of exemplary behaviour and presentation (successful applicants are required to represent St John's in correct College uniform)
- A satisfactory interview with the Principal, Deputy Principal – Pastoral Care and the Head of HPE and Sport
- Two character references from either, a current teacher, a current sporting coach or a Minister of Religion
