Thank you sincerely for your ongoing support of St John's Anglican College throughout 2022. We continue to be mindful of the ongoing repercussions from the pandemic, now coupled with rising inflation and interest rates, and understand the impacts on both the College and our families. As these challenges continue, so too does our drive to build upon our strengths and nurture every student to their greatest potential. The needs of the St John's community remain the centre of our focus as always. We are seeing further expansion and success in our academic excellence programs, have great pride in both our sporting culture and performing arts programs, and continue to invest in our Faith Mission and Wellbeing Centre.

To support our growth and best teaching practices, we must also invest in facilities for both our current and future generations. 2022 has seen some progress in this area, with significant refurbishments of classrooms on both the Senior and Junior Campus. In terms of our refurbishment program, we are now planning some upgrades to the Middle School science laboratories and specialist teaching areas. Of course, our focus on new facilities will now be directed towards the much awaited Aquatic Centre, which will not only provide a new Olympic grade swimming pool, but state-of-the-art learn to swim facilities and a suite of new classrooms – all linked to our magnificent new sports centre which was completed in June 2020.

There has been much media coverage on inflation and wage increases, led in part by the Queensland Government's adjustment to teacher salaries this year. It is encouraging to see the value placed on these essential members of our community, and I am pleased to advise that, despite this and the rising costs experienced by us all, we have managed to cap the average fee increase to 3.5% across the College.
