The St John's Anglican College Council have continued to monitor how this situation effects members of our community. Students, staff and all families have been our primary focus in 2021 to ensure we have the right resources in the right places to support those in need. I am also pleased that, in partnership with the College leadership team, we have successfully kept our International College doors open for business, further consolidated our academic excellence programs, reinvigorated our sporting culture and continued to enjoy the success of our performing arts program, evidenced by the High School Musical earlier in the year. As you learned earlier this year, we have commissioned a major capital works program that will result in St John's Anglican College building an Olympic grade Aquatic Centre prior to the 2032 Brisbane Olympics, that will also provide a suite of state-of-the-art classrooms. We are proud to say that we are one step closer to becoming the premier school of choice on the southwest side of Brisbane.

With all of this positive news, we still need to account for the standard annual growth in wages and operating expenses across all areas of the college operations while ensuring our staff are resourced appropriately to deliver increasing value in all areas of your children's curricular and co-curricular activities. I am pleased to advise that we have again managed to cap the average fee increase to 2.5% across the College.
