## RISE Sporting Scholarship Criteria

The RISE sporting scholarship **R**ecognises and **I**nspires **S**porting Excellence.

Students will be expertly coached by a highly qualified coaching team in a fun and exciting environment in St John's recently redeveloped sports centre.

### Scholarship benefits

- Part remission of tuition fees, with a maximum offer of 75%.
- Personal mentoring and goal setting support.
- Access to strength and conditioning sessions.
- Access to nutritional sessions.
- Access to sports psychology sessions.
- Academic support (where required).
- Access to College sporting camps.

### Criteria

- Students commencing in Year 7 or Year 10 in 2023.
- Student must attend an athletic performance testing day (dates outlined below).
- Students are required to commit to play a school sport each trimester as per the sports detailed by The Associated Schools (TAS) competition.
- Evidence of Regional, State or National representation on chosen sport within the last 12 months as well as future potential in sport.
- A Commitment to a minimum of two trimesters of sport with a recommendation of playing in all three trimesters of sport during Term 1, 2 and 3. One of which must be the student's specialist sport.
- A commitment to compete in two of the following TAS Carnivals: Swimming, Cross Country or Athletics
- Applicants must be able to maintain the equivalent of a C grade, or higher in all subjects.
- Maintaining a VG grade or higher in Engagement with Learning, Preparedness for Learning in classes and Classroom Behaviour.
- Evidence of exemplary behaviour and presentation (successful applicants are required to represent St John's in correct College uniform).
- A satisfactory interview with the Principal or delegate and the Sports and Specialised Activities Manager.
- Two-character references from either a current teacher or a current sporting coach.
- A demonstrated sense of community.
- Exhibit qualities compatible with the Anglican ethos and values of St John's
- A demonstrated capacity to lead.
- Represent St John's in the preferred sport if played at club level.
