## Enrolling Students

Students new to the College are fitted for their uniform by appointment only. Parents wishing to make appointments should contact the uniform shop directly.

## Uniform Expectations

The College uniform as prescribed must be worn at all times whilst attending and travelling to and from school. Whilst in College uniform, students must recognise that they represent the school, be proud of the uniform and wear it neatly. Parents have a responsibility to ensure their child/ren leave home each day correctly attired. Staff will then supervise this at College.

### The Wearing of the College Uniform

The wearing of the College uniform has always been a part of St John's Anglican College and will continue to be so. High standards of uniform wear and grooming are important in the College as this makes an important statement to the wider community about the College and the way it sees itself. Further, a student's personal standard of uniform wear and grooming may indicate how the student sees him/herself personally and how he/she feels about the College.

Often the policing of uniform standards and grooming falls to the teaching staff when it is a shared responsibility. Parents who enrol their children in St John's Anglican College must accept the responsibility to outfit their child in the correct uniform and see that it is worn correctly each day to and from school.

### Some Common Concerns Relating to the Uniform are Listed Below:

#### Blazers

- Blazers must be worn to and from school every day during Term Two and Three and on formal occasions and excursions.

#### Tie and Badges

- The House badge is worn on the girls tie under the embroidered College badge.
- The boys' tie is worn pulled up to the topmost button. The House badge is worn on the left breast pocket of the formal shirt on the right-hand side of this pocket or on the Collegetie.
- The College badge is worn on the right lapel of the blazer.

### **Dress Hat**

- The dress hat is worn everyday with the dress uniform whenever on College grounds and for formal occasions and excursions. Hairstyle must not affect the correct wearing of the hat.

### **Yard Hat**

- The yard hat is to be worn at morning tea, lunch and during PE lessons. All students must take a hat to Swimming, Cross Country and Athletics Carnivals.

### **Hair**

- Students' hair should be neat, tidy and clean at all times. Hair must not be coloured. Extremes of style are not acceptable. Use of hair products is not permitted.
- Tracks, steps or wedges are not allowed. Hair length must be above the collar. Boys' hairstyles which allow the hair to fall across the face or eyes are not permitted.
- Girls with hair longer than shoulder-length must wear it up. Ribbons or scrunchies must be in College colours (red, white or navy). Very short hairstyles are not permitted.
- All male students are to present clean-shaven (unless dispensation is given by Head of College on cultural grounds). Sideburns must not be longer than the ear lobe.
- The Head of College reserves the right to determine whether a hairstyle is acceptable. A student may be asked to refrain from attending College until his/her hairstyle is deemed acceptable.

### **Tattoos**

- Tattoos of any type (visible or invisible) are not permitted while a student is enrolled at the College.

### **Jewellery**

- For boys, the only jewellery permitted is a plain watch.
- For girls, the only jewellery permitted is a plain watch and one set of small silver or gold sleepers or studs, worn in the lower part of the ear lobe. No stones or gems are permitted.
- Students are not permitted to wear clear plastic fillers.
- No body piercings/adornments are permitted.

### **Makeup**

- Students are not permitted to wear makeup in College uniform (including clear lip gloss).
- Students who need to wear makeup for medical reasons need to seek written permission from the Head of College.

### **Shoes**

- Dress shoes are black leather lace-up and worn with the dress uniform.

### **Socks**

- Girls' socks are a College formal sock.
- Boys' trouser socks are a College formal sock worn at calf length.
- Boys' shorts socks are a College long formal sock.

### **Trousers/Skirts/Shorts**

- The girls' blouse and skirt are worn every day; the skirt is worn on the waist, below the knee at mid-calf, the blouse is worn resting on the hip and over the skirt. As an option, Girls Navy Trousers are available for all female students in Prep to Year 12.
- The boys' shirt and shorts/trousers are worn every day; trousers are worn on the waist, with black leather embossed college belt, the shirt is worn tucked in. College dress shorts are compulsory for boys in Years 7 to 9 in Terms One and Four and the trousers are worn in Terms Two and Three.
- Shorts for Year 10 students are optional in Terms One and Four.
- Trousers are worn all year for students in Years 11 and 12.

### **Sports/PE Uniforms**

- The dress uniform is worn to and from the College and Senior School Students change into their sports uniform for the sport's lesson then change back into their dress uniform. The sport's uniform is NOT to be worn to and from school by Senior School Students.
- The sports/yard hat is navy bucket with red trim and is worn in accordance to Cancer Council recommendation.
- Sports socks are ankle style College socks.
- Sports shoes should be predominately white running shoes on the Junior Campus. No Fluro shoes are allowed on either Campus.
- The track jacket and pants are to be worn with the sports uniform only.
- Full sports kit (including sports jackets in winter) is to be worn to all TAS sports fixtures.

### **Bags**

- Students to use the College backpack to carry books to and from school. The sports bag is only to be used for TAS sports fixtures.

### **Uniform Infringements**

Please note that a uniform infringement process is in place for students. Students who accumulate three or more uniform infringements within a semester will receive a community service detention at the discretion of the Head of House.

## College House System

There are four houses at St John's Anglican College that are unique to the College and reflect its origins. Each house is allocated a significant colour and Chinese character.



**Braithwaite House** takes its name from Mr John Braithwaite founding member of the Board of Forest Lake College.

House colour – **Red**



**Delbeta House** takes its name from the original developers of the suburb of Forest Lake – Delfin property Group and B+B Australia.

House colour – **Dark Green**



**Bow Qing Tian House** reflects our commitment to Mandarin Chinese. Bow Qing Tian was known as the greatest and wisest judge according to Chinese legend.

House colour – **Light Blue**



**Archerfield House** takes its name from Archerfield Station, which is the land on which Forest Lake is built.

House colour – **Dark Blue**

Students are allocated to a House soon after enrolment. All students in the same family are allocated to the same House where possible. Athletics, Cross Country and Swimming carnivals, as well as competition in cultural areas such as debating, music and service initiatives are examples of events in the College calendar where students have the opportunity to represent their house. Students are notified of their house allocation when purchasing their uniform so that a House badge can be purchased as well as a House shirt for Year 6 Leaders and students in Years 7 to 12.

## UNIFORM CARE GUIDE

Please launder Secondary blouses and shirts and Primary dresses separately for the first wash. These items may then be laundered with your normal whitewash and can be soaked in nappy san if needed. It is not advisable to leave whites in the machine for an extended time once the washing cycle has finished.

Secondary skirts and trousers and Primary shorts should be washed with similar dark colours in cold water and hung inside out in the shade to prevent fading.

Sports polos may be washed with either darks or whites. Do not wash with dark colours if you have an item that may run. Ironing of sportswear is not required however if you do wish to iron your uniform, it is advised to try a cool iron and put a fabric between the garment and the iron. Only press the iron down on the polo, do not push or run the iron over the garment.

Girls and Boys ties can be washed in a laundry bag.

## CARE INSTRUCTIONS FOR FORMAL HATS

To ensure your hat continues to look its best, it is advised to undertake some basic cleaning approximately once a term.

### Girls White Hat:

Soak the hat overnight in nappy-san or laundry detergent. Scrub soiled area gently with a small soft nailbrush or similar. Rinse under cold water and dry in the shade, flat on a towel.

### Boys Grey Hat:

Wipe over with a warm soapy cloth then rinse as above.

**DO NOT MACHINE WASH, TUMBLE DRY OR PLACE IN DISHWASHER.**
